Bar graphs depicting the seasonal distribution of all 366 regularly occurring bird species found in Trinidad and Tobago appear in W.L. Murphy's, **A Birder's Guide to Trinidad and Tobago**, available for US\$12.95 plus US\$1.50 shipping from Peregrine Enterprises, Inc. This book covers all aspects of travelling to and exploring the bird life of these fascinating islands as well as providing maps and photographs of many interesting areas.

The tape includes the songs and calls of nearly 40 species of birds found on the islands of Trinidad and Tobago. It also features a segment in which two of the most complicated bird vocalizations are played at greatly reduced speed.
